SCHOOL TIMETABLE

- School begins at 8.45 am every morning
- At 9.43 am there is a tutor class every day
- Monday Thursday school ends at 3.34 pm
- On Friday school ends at 1.04 pm
- Each class is 58 minutes long

Students are given their Journals by their tutors on the first day of school.

- First years have a group specific journal with content aimed at becoming a Successful Post Primary Student
- Used for:

Recording homework (Written and Learning)
General communication between the teachers and parents/guardians

- Academic Monitoring
- The class tutors check the journals every week.
- Parent/guardians must check and sign the journal EVERY week.

Taking care to check for graffiti, inappropriate drawings/words. The journal should be kept in a neat and presentably condition at all times

Attendance is linked directly to performance in school

Students must attend ALL day every day

If a child is absent a note must be provided to explain the absence.

More than 20 days absence Tusla must be informed

A student must report to the office if late in the morning.

Illness during the day- student to report to a Yearhead/Deputy Principal/Principal with permission from the teacher.

Parents may be telephoned to collect child if illness does not pass.

<u>Students can only contact parents through</u> the main office – not through mobile phones.

At Lunch time:

•FIRST YEAR students are not allowed to leave the school grounds (this applies to 2nd & 3rd Years too)





MOBILE PHONES & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- Mobile phones are not permitted tp be used on school grounds during the school day for First Years (and next years Second Years).
- If a mobile device is brought to school it is to be kept powered off and in their schoolbag.

- Any contact that needs to be made with a student/ parent during the day must be through the office.
- If a phone is seen during the school day it may be confiscated and held until the end of the day by the Deputy Principal.
- If the phone has to be confiscated a number of times it will be kept for a longer period of time, parents/ guardians will be informed of this. Further sanctions may be imposed for repeat offenses.

Common teenager excuses:

- 'we got no homework"
 very unlikely but they should still revise the work done that day
- 'I got it done in a free class'.....very unlikely but they should still revise the work done that day

 Text/ phone/ social network.
- 'I don't understand it'..... They should sit down and write out 5 things from the topic they have difficulty in understanding. Time should be spent in trying rather than just giving up instantly.

Having a set routine of 1-1.5 hours EVERY week night will help avoid arguments about homework!

Develop an appreciation of the civilisations of the ancient Greek and Roman worlds and the ancient Greek and Latin languages

ALL DE LE

Classics gives students the opportunity to engage with the culture, literature, languages, art and material culture of Ancient Greece and Rome in a variety of ways. The course comprises three strands, and students will study two out of these three strands. The first strand, core component – myth and daily life, will be taken by all students. Alongside this, students have the option of studying either the Classical Studies component (World of Achilles and Rome, Centre of an Empire) or the Classical Language component (Latin or Ancient Greek).



Music

Supported by formative assessment across the three years

The specification for Junior Cycle Music focuses on giving students the opportunity to develop their musical knowledge, skills and cultural awareness through the practical and cognitive engagement with music.

This can be achieved through the three interconnected strands: 1. Procedural knowledge 2. Innovate and ideate 3. Culture and context.

New Senior Cycle

- Senior Cycle is undergoing significant redevelopment to enhance the learning experience and assessment methods.
- By the time they are in Senior Cycle, most, if not all of their subjects will have a project to go with the written exam.
- These projects are called Additional Assessment Components (AACs). They will account for at least 40% of the overall grade.
